7 School Development Plan, Monitoring Priorities for the Academic Year

Governors worked with SC on the SDP by adding questions for the Governors. These questions will tie into the Governors Monitoring. Governors consider recent achievement data and relate some of their questions back to this.

SDP 2023/24

SC asks Governors to come and watch a Decision Spelling lesson and feedback.

Are there enough good quality books available to children at the schools?

SC states there has been a lot of work on the books available to KS1 children. Teachers have found it is better to have a smaller amount of good quality books available to children rather than overwhelming them with lots of lesser quality ones. KS2 books will be reviewed.

Governors make a note to check all children's reading when carrying out monitoring visits - especially PP and SEN children's reading - what they are currently reading and what they have enjoyed. The school would like to make sure all children are reading for pleasure. They could also check the children's reading logs.

How is reading encouraged in class?

KS2 classes all read a novel together. Guided reading also takes place. There are class libraries children can borrow books from. Reading records should be kept too.

As part of the SDP SC added her aim for the schools to work even more collaboratively, sharing work and prioritising relationships - between staff as well as the relationships between staff and children.

Teaching staff had fed back to HTs that they wanted more time to be able to get to know the children and build relationships with them which fits with the new Relational Approach to behaviour at the federation. At the recent Courageous Camping trip staff were able to take part in activities alongside children rather than running all the activities.

The Relational Approach takes time, HTs want to assure staff that it is worth the extra work rather than going back to a traditional behavioural approach.

ACTION - CO to talk to all teachers, not just SENDCO, regarding the impact of the new Wake and Shake sessions, which has been moved from early morning to before break time. The change has taken place as it was found that children who didn't like to take part in the session were more likely to be late.

Christian distinctiveness in the SDP, after speaking with Rebecca Nye, is also focused on connections - with ourselves, each other and nature.
